



## WHAT IS CHICAGO FEST WEST?

Chicago Fest West (CFW) is a family-friendly cultural event that celebrates all-things Chicago with a full day of live music, food, dance and fanfare. The 2023 Chicago Fest West takes place the last weekend of April and is being held in conjunction with the Sangria Festival. The Sangria Festival is taking place on Saturday, April 29th, while Chicago Fest West is taking place on Sunday, April 30th.

Chicago Fest West is held at Mesa's Riverview Park, just north of Rio Salado Parkway and east of the Cubs Sloan Park Stadium along CUBS WAY (2020 Cubs Way, Mesa, Arizona 85201).

DJ music begins at 1pm. Live bands start at 2:00 pm. The festival will end at 9:30 pm.

We recommend that you buy in advance, as the cost increases for each ticket purchased the day of the event.

### Can we purchase tickets at the gate?

Yes. However, the cost at the door does increase to \$26.00 for a General Admission ticket and \$120 for a Dugout ticket.

#### Do I have to wear a wristband?

Yes. Tickets will be scanned at the events and festival attendees over 21 will be provided with a wristband upon admittance. Those 21 and over with a VIP Dugout ticket will be provided a special wristband.

# **PARKING INFORMATION**

Festival parking is \$5.00 in the east side lot, just north of Cubs Way and in the parking garage. The nearby parking garage provides covered parking. Drivers will be directed to the parking garage upon arrival once surface parking is full, as the parking garage is usually the last parking area filled.

Handicap and VIP parking is available, and those in need will be directed to the Handicap parking lot north of Cubs Way on the westside of the festival site. See parking map below.



# **EVENT SECURITY**

Patrons are subject to a search upon entry. Security screening may be requested by law enforcement personnel before entry.

All bags are subject to search before entry. While it is not required for bags to be clear, bags cannot be larger than 12x16.

Persons who do not comply with the search policy will be refused entry to the event.

# **REFUND POLICY**

This festival is a rain or shine event. Tickets are non-refundable.

However, if the festival is rescheduled, your passes will automatically be honored at the new date. Should you be unable to attend the new date, refunds will be offered within 30 days of the announced rescheduled date.

If the festival is canceled, your passes will be refunded through our ticket vendor. Chicago Fest West cannot verify the policies of third-party ticket resellers.

## **SMOKING GUIDELINES**

This is a family-friendly event. Smoking is allowed only in designated spaces at the festival. Please be courteous to non-smokers.

# **FAQ**

#### (Frequently Asked Questions)

#### Q: Is this festival ADA accessible?

A: Yes. There will be ADA bathrooms and parking available.

#### Q: If I leave the festival, can I re-enter the festival again later?

A: Reentry is prohibited, unless you have a VIP ticket.

#### Q: Is this a cash or credit event?

A: Credit is preferred. However, both will be accepted. Vendors at the festival will decide what form of payment they want. CFW highly recommends credit/debit cards for payment, even the \$5 parking fee.

#### Q: Should I bring sunscreen and wear a hat?

A: Arizona can get very hot, even in April with plenty of sunshine. We suggest that you were a Hat (Chicago Sports Teams are a good bet) Therefore, please come prepared with sunscreen, water, hat and a blanket to relax on. Folding chairs are allowed too. Evenings do cool off but that is not until the sun goes down!

### Q: Where can I stay near the Chicago Fest West Festival?

A: The Marriott and Sheridan are located on the Riverview Park property, however there are also numerous lodging options near the venue.

#### Q: Is there a Lost and Found on site?

A: Yes. If you lose an item proceed to the main entrance. There is a Lost and Found located at the information booth inside the festival area.

### Q: Are there medical and/or first aid services on site?

A: Yes. There is a medical and first aid tent near the main festival entrance.

#### Q: Will there be free drinking water available?

A: There will be free refill stations for service animals inside the festival. However, patrons should be prepared to purchase drinking water should they want it. Water can be brought into the venue, when in approved sealed plastic bottles.

#### Q: Can I bring an umbrella?

A: Yes. Personal sized umbrellas are permitted to shade from the Arizona sun. However, large sized umbrellas (i.e. pool/beach umbrellas) are not permitted. When using an umbrella, please be considerate of those around you.

#### Q: Will there be a dance area near the stage?

A: Yes. This year's event will have a designated dance area for people to move their bodies and enjoy the music.

### Q: Is this event pet-friendly?

A: No. Unfortunately to maintain safety of people and pets, only service animals are permitted at Chicago Fest West. We can expect 15,000 people and things can get very crowded.

### Q: Can I bring medical supplies to Chicago Fest West?

A: If you need to bring in medical items or supplies, identify yourself to security prior to entering the venue. Security will alert the appropriate medical staff who will provide a secure area to store all items. Please note there is no needle disposal available. Therefore, all medical needles need to be secured by the user and then taken to a proper medical disposal unit offsite.

Medical items that are not available for purchase on-site may be brought in. Please note that you may need to provide an official doctor's note or prescription confirming the item's necessity.

### Q: How can I get to Chicago Fest West?

A: The Mesa Riverview park is located on the northwest corner of Dobson Rd and Rio Salado Parkway. Rio Salado can be reached via an exit off of the 101 Freeway and Dobson can be reached off of the 202 Red Mountain freeway. Once you exit off of Dobson and onto Cubs Way, drive approximately 800 feet and the Chicago Fest West site is just north of Cubs Way in the ball fields. **See Map.** If you exit

onto Rio Salado from the 101, drive approximately ¾ of a mile and enter off of Sheffield Rd and follow it around to Cubs Way. The festival is east of Sheffield Rd. There is parking available on-site for a fee of \$5. However, the park is also accessible via Uber, Lyft, or taxi services. Depending on your location, it may also be within walking/biking distance.
